A word from our principal.

Dear Families,

When we return from spring vacation, our third through sixth grade classes will begin taking the spring ISAT Assessment for English Language Arts, Math, and 5th grade Science. They will take one test per week beginning on Tuesday, April 10th, and ending May 10th. Please visit with your child about the importance of doing their best on each test. If a student is absent on their scheduled testing day, they will have to make-up their test when they return.

Our kindergarten through 3rd grade will also be participating in our Idaho Reading Indicator assessment, district writing assessment, and district math assessment in early May. All of these end-of-year assessments will help us identify each child's strengths and weaknesses so that we can plan for future lessons. This information also helps our staff monitor the effectiveness of our programs and instructional strategies so that we can make adjustments where needed.

Please make sure your child/children get a good night sleep on school nights. When students are extremely tired, it is difficult for them to concentrate and get along with their peers. During 4th quarter we will continue teaching students specific strategies to use in a variety of social settings. Thank you for your help and supportworking together we can help our kids be successful!

Report cards will be sent home on Friday, April 13th. Although we do not have scheduled spring conferences, we are always available to discuss your child's progress. Just call the office to schedule an appointment.

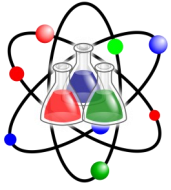
